# **INSTRUCTIONS**

## **USAGE**

The treated surface must be clean, dry and solid. During the applying and drying of the oil, the temperature of the oil, air and surface must be above +8 °C degrees and the relative humidity below 80 %. Thinner: water.

Apply an even layer of oil with a brush or cloth. Absorbent surfaces should be treated several times until the surface is saturated. Wipe off excess oil after an hour. First clean the brush with white spirit and then with soap water.

### **SAFETY**

WARNING: Danger of spontaneous combustion in rags and cotton waste. Rags must be disposed of properly, e.g. by immersing in water or burning. (See Safety data sheet).

#### **ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AND WASTE DISPOSAL**
